Thank you for registering to attend the Southeast Regional Clinical & Translational Science Conference scheduled for March 3rd and 4th at Callaway Gardens in Pine Mountain, Georgia.

Please know that the health and safety of all conference center guests and staff is our number one priority. To ensure everyone's health and safety during the conference, please be aware that we will follow CDC recommended COVID-19 safety guidelines and take appropriate action.

- Symptoms – please do not attend the conference if you have any COVID-19 symptoms.
- Immunization – all attendees are encouraged to be fully vaccinated with a booster.
- Masks – we require high quality surgical/procedure masks or better to be worn properly covering both the nose and mouth while attending the conference indoors. We encourage you to bring your own, but also will have free masks available throughout the conference.
- Testing – you must test prior to entering the conference. It is recommended that you plan to present proof of a negative PCR test two days before arrival to avoid delays. Alternatively, you may submit to a free rapid test upon arrival at the conference registration table, but should plan to arrive early to avoid delays.
